

Disabled Access

The ground floor is all on one level with a separate toilet designed for wheelchair users. There is a wheelchair lift to the first floor. Both halls are fitted with an induction loop system.

Centre Equipment

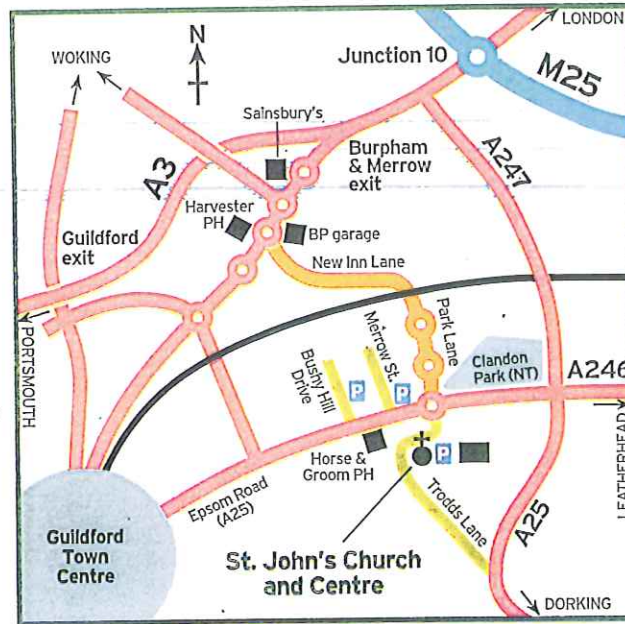
Flip charts, Overhead Projector, Television and Video are available.

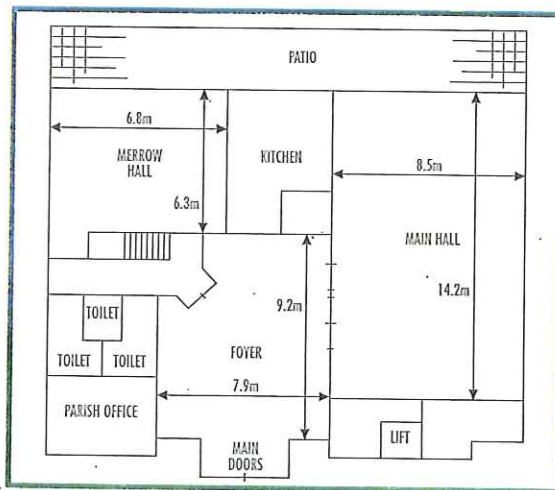


The Main Hall

The Centre is an ideal facility for community and care groups and for private functions such as Weddings, Baptisms and Funerals, as well as children's and adults' parties.

Ground Floor Accommodation

The Foyer has a spacious and welcoming aspect with coffee and tea served by friendly volunteers during the week. It is ideal for receiving wedding guests and can also be used for hospitality or arranging displays.



Ground Floor

The Main Hall is very attractive with beams and a light oak wood floor. It is large enough to seat 175 in theatre fashion and up to 150 at tables. There are flexible facilities for staging and lighting to suit drama productions and with a modern sound system and upright piano this makes it a popular venue for all functions. When needed, additional room can be obtained by opening the two sets of arched glass doors between Hall and Foyer.



The Foyer

The Small Hall also has a wood oak floor, a sound system and pull-down projector screen. It can seat about 40 people. With its doors to the peaceful churchyard and patio area, this is ideal for community groups, smaller meetings and informal occasions.

The Kitchen is equipped with extensive and up-to-date catering facilities. White crockery and cutlery is provided for 150 place settings. There are two serving hatches, which open onto the main hall and foyer.



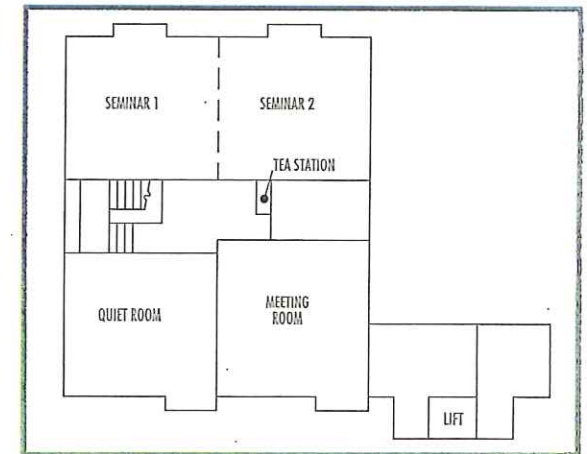
Seminar Room

First Floor Accommodation

The Seminar Room with a seating capacity for about 50 people can be divided into two. There is an adjacent tea/coffee station providing instant boiling water.

The Meeting Room, with its white board, can be used for committee meetings. It also has a piano, making it suitable for use by music and youth groups.

The Quiet Room is reserved for sessions such as bereavement counselling, volunteer groups and for deanery and diocesan meetings.
